Gilbert GALLAND 1870-1956

Gilbert Galland studied with Hippolyte DUBOIS in Marseille (South of France). He also exhibited his works (especially sights of Marseille, Brittany and Oriental scenes), the 'Salon des Artistes'. Gilbert Galland is the one who decorated the famous restaurant 'Le Train Bleu' (The Blue Train) at the Lyon Train Station in Paris. In 1889, Galland went to Algeria, where he took part in the creation of the 'Société des Peintres Orientalistes Algériens' (Company of Algerian Orientalist painters) in 1897. He then went travelling together with Maxime Noiré.
