**Roger GODCHAUX**

**1878-1958**

Roger Godchaux always liked painting, and after classical studies, he turned to Art. Teachers found him gifted but Roger Godchaux had to stop for a while for national service.

He then went back to Art and his first exhibitions began in 1905, especially at the Salon des Artistes Français, where he showed a lion, followed the years after by more artworks, including sculptures.

Roger Godchaux left for War and used there his artistic talent.

Painting many animals, he sent some of his art to Rudyard KIPLING

In 1919, Roger Godchaux got back to the Salon des Artistes Français, before getting into the Salon des Artistes Animaliers in 1920.

In June 1922, Godchaux obtained a medal from the Committee of the Society of French Artists, and in 1925, he was given another one from the Jury of the Exhibition of the Arts Décoratifs et Industriels.

The State also ordered a few items from Roger Godchaux.
